
The price of this trip is £48, students will be taken by coach to Nottingham, departing at 11:00 and returning to Longsands by, approximately, 20:00. Students should bring a packed lunch and dinner, including water (fizzy drinks are not permitted), please ensure that this is in a disposable bag. Students may bring some spending money for refreshments and/or programmes in the theatre, please be aware that these can be expensive and students will be responsible for any money that they bring.

ParentPay will open for payment from 9.00 am on 4 January 2019. If your child would like a place on this trip, please pay £48 as soon as possible. Please note that only 57 places are available and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. When completing ParentPay, we ask that you provide an emergency contact number for the day of the trip, as well as relevant medical information in the mandatory notes section. If you have any difficulty accessing your ParentPay account, please contact the Finance Department on 01480 223336/37.

If your son/daughter is eligible for Pupil Premium funding, you may be able to access financial support for this trip. Pupil Premium funding is available for students who have been eligible for free school meals in the last 6 years, are looked after or have parents in the armed forces. Further advice on eligibility for Pupil Premium funding is available on our website. If you are not eligible for Pupil Premium but are currently experiencing financial hardship, the Academy may be able to support you. If you wish to apply for Pupil Premium or discuss current financial hardship, please write to or email Mrs F Smith (fsmith@longsands.cambs.sch.uk). If you are applying for financial support, please pay a £5 deposit to reserve a place on the trip and then contact Mrs Smith immediately to discuss the remaining payment.
