Home Learning Club now Monday to Friday after school in the library

We are very pleased to inform you that the Home Learning Club will now be running every night after school. The club takes place every day after school from 3.10 - 4.10 pm, in the Academy Library. This is an excellent opportunity for your child to complete home learning tasks and to receive support or clarification with any aspect of their set work, before leaving the Academy.

The Library provides a safe and happy working environment and includes an ideal study space, access to a wide range of research materials, the use of ICT facilities and all of the books in the Library. Support will be available from dedicated staff to give support and guidance to students and, furthermore, students will also be able to receive peer support from St Neots Sixth Form student volunteers. At secondary school level completion of tasks set outside the classroom can help students accelerate their learning by as much as 5 additional months each year!

If your son/daughter needs support in specific subject areas, then they should also continue to use subject clinics/clubs; you can find this information in the 'latest news' section of the academy website.

This facility is open to students on a drop in basis but if we find that students are regularly not completing home learning tasks then students may be directed to attend this club so that we can support them in completing home learning tasks and help all students to reach their full potential.

Please note, in the event of a child receiving a detention the same afternoon, students will be expected to attend their set detention first before arriving at the Home Learning Club.

Please do encourage your child to make the most of this fantastic opportunity and support them in attending on a regular basis.
